Jesus Christ. Brief ministry report has been enlisted below.***

I. JULY

7. Met field evangelists personally in their house, discussed the issues of difficulty in set up proper fellowship/church and elaborated on the matter of how to re-strategize in order to establish it. Furthermore, prayed and encouraged them to be able to stand in their own feet in the near future.
8. Cleared the grasses and cleaned our colony road twice in these couple of months, as the road is yet to be blacktopped.

IV. TESTIMONIES

1. The love and the grace of our living Lord have been evident in our ministry, we are truly grateful for His goodness. We are able hear and witness His miraculous acts in His ministry, we lay our hands and pray in Name of Jesus Christ along with you for sick people like a lady by name Laxmi, who was mentally ill and dumb for 20 years was restored.
2. Another thyroid patient, who was medically suspected to be cancer but could not afford medical bills for further investigation: whose throat was swollen, unable to eat solid foods and difficulty in talking, we simply pray in Jesus name over a glass of water and made her drink it, gradually she is improving (80%) by God's grace and through your prayers.
3. On the 27 of August, as I shared the living word of God in one of the fellowships, I took the



opportunity to do an altar call, many sick people came forward. The next Sunday three of them stood up and shared their testimonies of healing. One of them had her whole leg swollen and was in a painful condition but was completely healed.

4. TESTIMONY FROM ROSY (my wife): Every pregnancy is different and this time (2nd pregnancy) was a challenging one from the beginning with small complications physically. But on the 7th month after the ultrasound report, whereby it was determined that the baby was in a breech position and the placenta was in a low lying position, everything spiraled downwards from there. The reason is because these two combinations was one of the worst combinations medically and also for someone vying for a normal delivery (I was very adamant about having one).

Went to see another doctor for a 2nd opinion and when the doctor after looking at my report said that she would never admit me in their hospital if I were to try for normal delivery because chances were so high for the placenta to rupture and cause bleeding. That's when the severity of the situation hit us like and tension and anxiety arose. In the midst of all that God was the one who gave us courage, hope, endurance and the ability to not give up. And with newfound fervor the prayers and fasting continued.

Then, on the 8th month when we went for our routine check up, the ultrasound report showed that the baby came to a normal position as well as the placenta went up to 2nd grade (80%) maturity, the doctor said that I can most definitely try for a normal delivery. Lifting the name of the Lord Jesus on high and I praise Him for having answered our prayers and the prayers of those who have been praying for us.

A prayer request: The expected delivery date is on the 11th of October 2023, kindly be praying for a safe and easy normal birth, thank you all.

Dear believers, your constant supports and prayers have made a huge impact in the lives of many in our mission field. Hence, though there are challenges, the ministry here in Lucknow is thriving especially under some native evangelists. Please continue to pray earnestly, so that the Lord may give us more harvest.

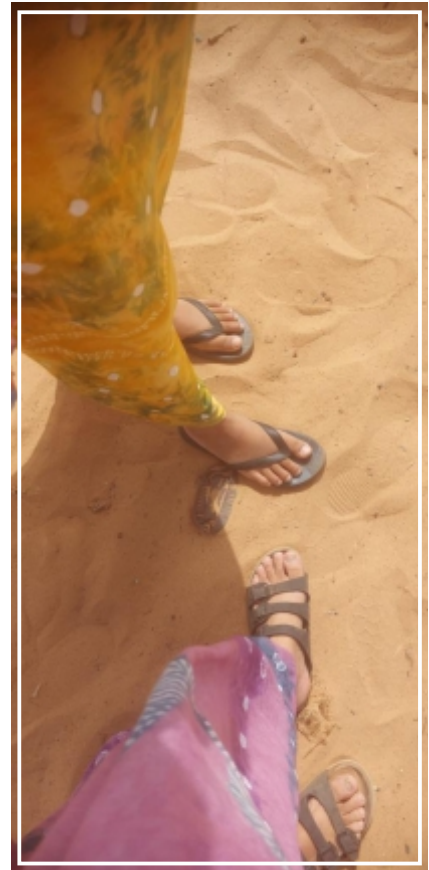

THE JOURNEY TO THE UNREACHED



As I return back home for Home Assignment, after 3 years and some months from the unknown and unreached land, a land I never imagined I will ever place my feet on, especially to share Christ, I remember “The Journey” I have taken that finally leads me where God called and placed me to be. A sixteen hours long flight, crossing seas and deserts, and continent, over long hours layover at different airports, that landed in a country which is very least known to many. The journey from Chad capital, N'djamena to a small town in North East of the country where I am based has been quite fascinating, which I can never forget; it is in some way traumatizing. The journey to my “Home” takes two days road trip. First part of the journey is surprisingly in a comfortable air-conditioned bus, but second part of the journey is unimaginable. Our trip end up in a very old land cruiser, with twenty-three of us, tons of luggage on the roof of the car, with two live sheep tight up who poops all over our window halfway the journey, children and adults all squeezed in, luggage all over our feet riding through the desert. Onto half the journey, the women at the back of the car where I share seats with other 20 passengers began to quarrel for space to rest their feet. It was the time when I had no sense of understanding or speaking single Arabic words. We were so cramped that we could not even move to have a sip of water from our bottles. My back was so sore and numb from the metal seat we were on for hours and hours. That time, I could not help but cry, beginning to question why God called and put me in such situation, only realizing after looking those faces of women and children in the car that I am here to love these people who haven't know Christ. After 11 hours of the ride in the desert, we reached a small town, a place that became my home. I have grown to love these people, love their food, love their clothes, which comes after much grace from God and much needed perseverance. In this small town, there are still thousands living and dying without Christ. There is so many to love and be kind to, genuinely loving so much as to be hurtful to let them die and live without knowing God. The field is so wide and the harvest is plentiful and so ready to be harvested lest it is too late. Handful of us in this field is so short of hands to love these people and reaching them the message of Salvation. Don't you want to be part of this blessing? This Journey has been the best journey taken so far in my life. Come and join us, there are lots to do and lots to reach out with the gospel of Truth.

INTERNSHIP MINISTRY REPORT



It has been a blessing interning at Kizari. I first attended Kizari Baptist Church Friday prayer and fasting program on 14th of July where I was asked to give a short testimony. First preached on 16th of July, Sunday Worship service on Matthew 14:25-31, entitled as “Renewing our Faith.” Along with Pastor, Associate Pastor, Youth Director and Prayer Chairman, we had our first home visitation on 21st of July after Friday evening service, followed by Saturday and Sunday, and continued the following Sundays, with a goal to visit all the 119 households in the village. I joined Government Primary School, Kizari, volunteering to help the children on some of the weekdays. The evenings are scheduled for music theory and piano classes.

My first impression has got to be their heart of giving and sharing, even the least that they have. 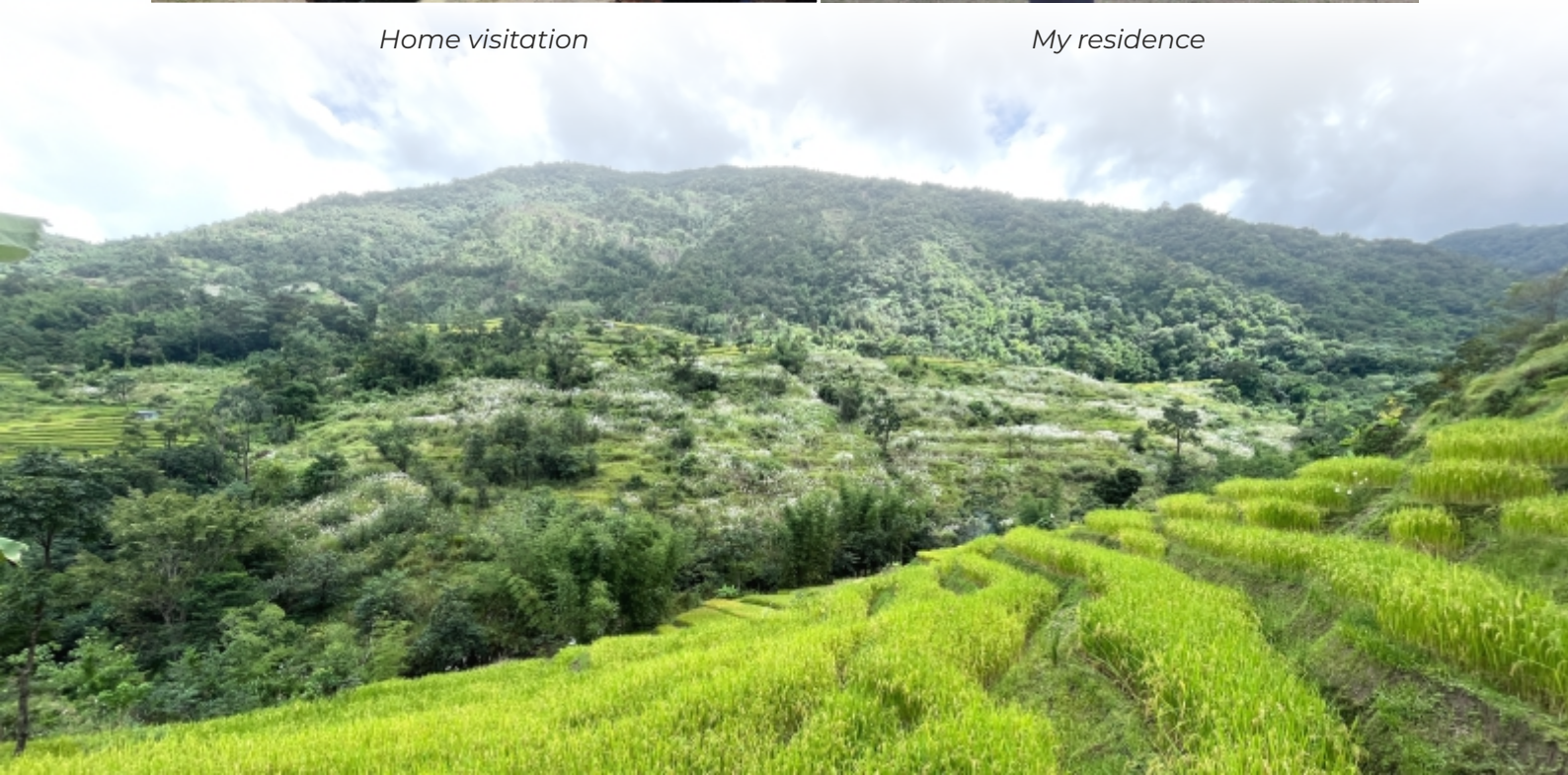

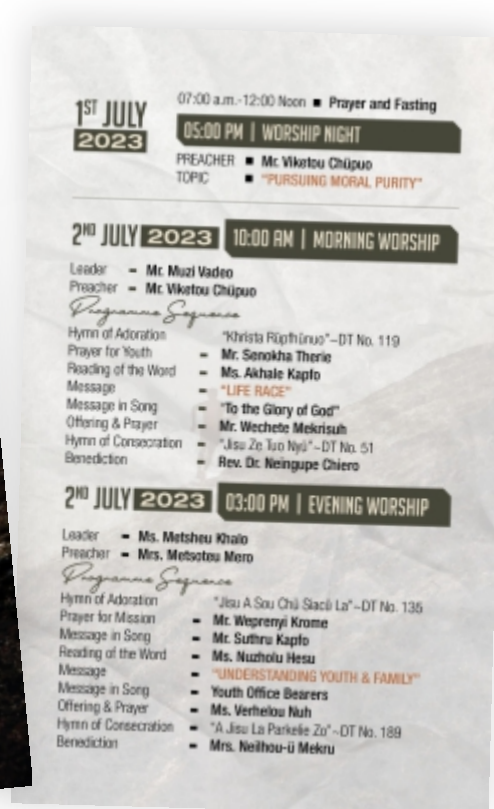
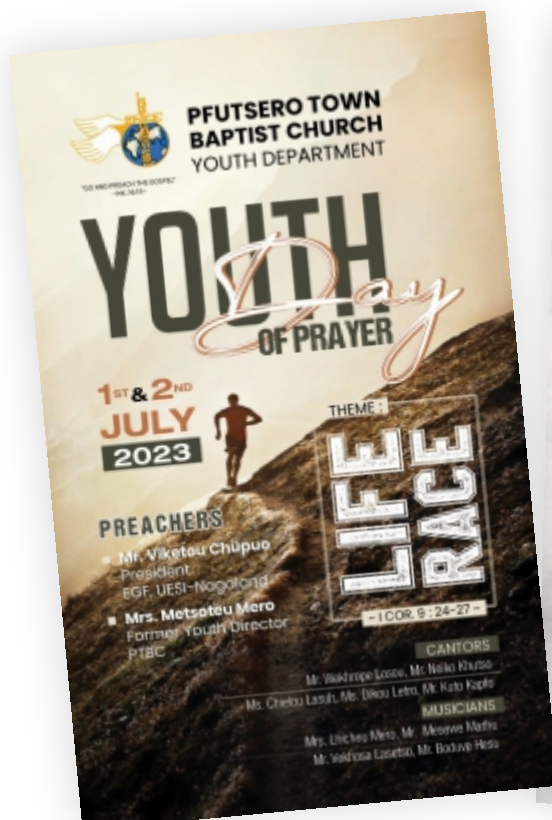
